**I. \_\_\_\_\_ AND GLORIFY GOD**

*Romans 15:14-15a* <sup>14</sup>“I myself am convinced, my brothers, that you yourselves are full of goodness, complete in knowledge and competent to instruct one another. <sup>15</sup>“I have written you quite boldly on some points, as if to remind you of them again,”

**A. LET \_\_\_\_\_ SHINE**

*Matthew 5:16* “In the same way, let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven.”

**B. LET \_\_\_\_\_ GROW**

*2 Peter 3:18* “But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To him be the glory both now and forever! Amen.”

**C. \_\_\_\_\_ AND LISTEN**

*John 10:3* “The watchman opens the gate for him, and the sheep listen to his voice. He calls his own sheep by name and leads them out.”

**II. \_\_\_\_\_ AND GLORIFY GOD**

*Romans 15:15b-16* <sup>15</sup>“...because of the grace God gave me <sup>16</sup>to be a minister of Christ Jesus to the Gentiles with the priestly duty of proclaiming the gospel of God, so that the Gentiles might become an offering acceptable to God, sanctified by the Holy Spirit.”

*Matthew 28:19* “Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the

*Son and of the Holy Spirit.”*

**III. BE \_\_\_\_\_ IN GLORIFYING GOD**

*Romans 15:17-21* <sup>17</sup>“Therefore I glory in Christ Jesus in my service to God. <sup>18</sup>“I will not venture to speak of anything except what Christ has accomplished through me in leading the Gentiles to obey God by what I have said and done—<sup>19</sup>by the power of signs and miracles, through the power of the Spirit. So from Jerusalem all the way around to Illyricum, I have fully proclaimed the gospel of Christ. <sup>20</sup>“It has always been my ambition to preach the gospel where Christ was not known, so that I would not be building on someone else’s foundation. <sup>21</sup>“Rather, as it is written: ‘Those who were not told about him will see, and those who have not heard will understand.’”

*2 Corinthians 3:12* “Therefore, since we have such a hope, we are very bold.”

**B. SPEAK JESUS \_\_\_\_\_**

*2 Timothy 4:2* “Preach the Word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage—with great patience and careful instruction.”
